The MASTER IN "CULTURAL PROPERTY PROTECTION IN CRISIS RESPONSE" is organized by the Interdepartmental University School for Strategic Sciences (SUSS) of the University of Turin, in collaboration with the Italian Army Education and Training Command and School of Applied Military Studies, the Carabinieri Command for the Protection of Cultural Heritage. It has the technical-scientific support of the Fondazione Santagata for the Economics of Culture and is managed by CORIPE PIEMONTE.

BACKGROUND:

The importance and the role of culture in crisis and post crisis scenarios has relevantly raised in the recent years, due to the emerging of new forms of conflicts and to the intensification of disasters.

This raise of attention turned into international campaigns and into a global response towards heritage protection, communities identity and cultural expressions safeguarding, as well as the control of illicit traffics and activities.

In this context the Master in Cultural Property Protection in Crisis Response is designed for a mixed target of civilians, military personnel, NGOs, peacekeepers, and in general all the operators intervenig in armed conflits or disasters scenarios, as well as those ones operating in the post-conflict or post-disaster recovery process.

The program aims at preparing a future generation of professionals with a multidisciplinary background and advanced expertise in the protection of cultural property in time of crisis and, more widely, in increasing the capacities to enhance the role of culture for addressing the social reconciliation and economic recovery of affected areas.

PROGRAMME:

The Course is worth a total of **60 university credits**, for a total amount of **1.500 hours**.

The Master modules are:

1. Foundations of cultural heritage protection
2. The law of international protection of cultural heritage
3. The economics of cultural heritage
4. Illicit trafficking of cultural property
5. The politics of cultural heritage protection
6. Actions for cultural heritage protection
7. Information management
8. Project cycle management

All activities will be in English.

PERIOD AND VENUE:

Lectures during the on campus phases in Turin will be held at the **Italian Army Education and Training Command** and **School of Applied Military Studies**. Other Venues will be the Campus Luigi Einaudi and historical buildings in Turin.

The Course is structured in 3 phases:

- Assisted distance learning: 8th - 29th January 2024
- On campus phase: 5th February 2024 - 22th May 2024
- Distance individual study and project preparation: 23th May 2024 - December 2024

WHO CAN ATTEND:

A **bachelor degree** and fluency in written and spoken **English** are required.

A maximum number of **40 participants** is foreseen.

The course will be activated on condition that there are at least **15 participants**.
